WORK has continued with its focus on Widows & Orphans in these increasingly difficult times.

The economic problems in the World affect the poorest hugely. They are the immediate victims. Climate change is resulting in daily challenges in these poor rural areas. If there is no food – death! Drought and floods are affecting Kenya and the majority of our Widows & Orphans are reliant on subsistence farming.

WORK has just supplied 2 deep boreholes to 2 poor Communities. Each Borehole is providing clean water to many families in the respective communities. Clean water is essential to health and life. Many young kids die from diseases carried in unclean water.....

The groups have a Table Bank which is enabling them to send their grandkids to school as well as ensure there is food and clothing at home. These Widows are remarkable ladies & in many ways are the backbone of Kenyan life.

Developments at Namboboto...... The second project was to upgrade

Namboboto is a village in the very south of the area WORK covers. It is poor, isolated & a forgotten corner. WORK has supported a Health Centre (HC) here for many years. It serves a population of over 8,000 people. This year WORK has provided 2 important projects.....

First a deep borehole providing clean water to the HC & the Community:

The second project was to upgrade the HC Laboratory from a 'cupboard' to a functional Lab. Without a good Lab it is impossible to diagnose Malaria etc and many kids would die.....



The Lab will be opened in Oct 2023
